**HAMDEN** - The committee looking into proposed uses for the former Maselli Farm is holding a public opinion session tonight.

The committee is soliciting input on what to do with the 34 acres of town property.

The meeting will be held at 6:30 at Thornton Wilder Hall of Miller Library, 2901 Dixwell Ave.

Among the uses being proposed are several different type of farming operations, as well as a new **animal shelter** on two of the 34 acres.

The **shelter** committee and the Happy Tails Foundation have submitted plans for the **shelter** to be there, according to foundation President Dolores Giannini.

"Not only will this location fulfill the dire need of a **shelter**, it will be a tremendous asset as a learning tool and an important component for community events," said Giannini, who urges supporters to attend the meeting.
